# <u>ADP</u> – Ad Hoc Working Group on the Durban Platform for Enhanced Action

COP subsidiary body established by decision 1/CP.17 to develop a "new" legal framework (which became the Paris Agreement) under the Convention by 2015.

# APA – Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement

COP subsidiary body established by 1/CP.21 decision to prepare for entry into force of the Paris Agreement.

# Art. - Article of the Paris Agreement

# **<u>CBDRRC</u>** – Common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capabilities

International environmental law principle expressing "the need to evaluate responsibility for the remediation or mitigation of environmental degradation based on both historical contribution to a given environmental problem and present capabilities."

<u>CDM</u> – *Clean Development Mechanism* Emissions-reduction commitment defined by KP Art. 12.

# **CMA** – Conference of the Parties serving as the first meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement

Will convene upon <u>entry into force</u> of the Paris Agreement.

### <u>COP</u> – Conference of the Parties

Highest decision-making authority under the UNFCCC.

#### EU – European Union

#### GCF – Green Climate Fund

Multilateral financial mechanism under the UNFCCC that aims to support adaptation and mitigation goals in equal proportions in developing countries.

#### <u>GEF</u> – Global Environment Facility

Financial mechanism for the UN Convention on Biological Diversity and the UNFCCC.

GHG – Greenhouse Gas

#### **INDC** – Intended Nationally Determined Contributions

Emissions-reduction and other climate-action pledges that national governments submitted to the UNFCCC in anticipation of COP21 and the Paris Agreement.

#### **IPCC** – Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change

Scientific body under the COP that publishes periodic assessment reports pertaining to climate change.

ITMOs – Internationally transferred mitigation outcomes

#### Paris Agreement, Past & Future

Acronym List June 24, 2016 International trading in mitigation activities that Arts. 6.2–6.3 allow Parties to the Paris Agreement to may make while implementing NDCs.

#### KP – Kyoto Protocol

International climate agreement adopted in 1997 that commits its Parties to binding emissionsreduction targets.

#### **LDC** – Least Developed Country

48 countries the UN deems to be "the poorest and weakest segment of the international community" and that tend to be highly vulnerable to the impacts of climate change.

#### **LDCF** – Least Developed Country Fund

Fund established to support LDCs in developing and implementing national adaptation programmes of action; operated by the GEF.

#### **<u>LEG</u>** – Least Developed Countries Expert Group

Expert group established to provide technical support and advice to LDCs on adaptation activities.

#### **NDC** – Nationally Determined Contributions

Climate change actions Parties will be committed to once the Paris Agreement becomes effective (INDCs will transition into NDCs).

#### Para. – Paragraph of the COP21 Decision text

<u>**REDD+**</u> – Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation in Developing Countries Mechanism to reduce GHG gas emissions though sustainable forest management in developing countries.

#### <u>SBSTA</u> – Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technical Advice

One of two permanent subsidiary bodies established under the UNFCCC; specializes in "research and systematic observation of the climate system."

#### **<u>SCCF</u>** – Special Climate Change Fund

Financial mechanism that supports adaptation and technology transfer in developing countries; operated by the GEF.

#### <u>SIDS</u> – Small Island Developing States

Negotiating block consisting of ~40 low-lying islands that are extremely vulnerable to climate change impacts, namely sea-level rise.

<u>UNFCCC</u> – United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, or the Convention International environmental treaty adopted in 1992 to serve as the institutional framework for addressing climate change; its objective is to stabilize "greenhouse gas concentrations in the atmosphere at a level that would prevent dangerous anthropogenic interference with the climate system."

<u>WIM</u> – Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Loss and Damage mechanism created at COP19 that now serves as the governance mechanism for loss and damage under the Paris Agreement.
